This matter is before the North Carolina Medical Board ("Board") regarding Ramesh Loganathan Krishnaraj, M.D. ("Dr. Krishnaraj"), license number 9901228.

FACTUAL FINDINGS

On September 23, 2015, the Board entered into a Consent Order ("2015 Consent Order") with Dr. Krishnaraj in which his license was indefinitely suspended, which suspension was stayed upon compliance with certain terms and conditions including, but not limited to, maintaining and abiding by his contract with the North Carolina Professionals Health Program.

On April 23, 2020, Dr. Krishnaraj, through his counsel, requested that the Board relieve him of the terms and conditions of his 2015 Consent Order.

The Board recognizes that Dr. Krishnaraj has complied in all respects with his 2015 Consent Order.

The Board hereby orders that Dr. Krishnaraj be relieved of all obligations contained in the numbered paragraphs of his 2015

Consent Order. Nothing herein shall affect the public nature of Dr. Krishnaraj's 2015 Consent Order, and it shall remain a public document on the Board's website.
