This matter is before the North Carolina Medical Board ("Board") on the application of Stanley Manuel Pamfilis, M.D. ("Dr. Pamfilis") for a medical license. Dr. Pamfilis admits, and the Board finds and concludes, that:

STATUTORY AUTHORITY

The Board is a body duly organized under the laws of North Carolina and is the proper party to bring this proceeding under the authority granted it in Article 1 of Chapter 90 of the North Carolina General Statutes.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Board first issued Dr. Pamfilis a medical license on May 12, 2016. Dr. Pamfilis' North Carolina license expired on December 6, 2021, because he chose not to renew it.

Dr. Pamfilis has not practiced medicine since August 2019 and, as such, recognizes the need for a reentry plan to assist him safely back into the practice of medicine.

PROCEDURAL STIPULATIONS

Dr. Pamfilis acknowledges and agrees that the Board has jurisdiction over him and the subject matter of this case.

Dr. Pamfilis acknowledges that he has read and understands this Reentry Agreement and enters into it voluntarily.

The Board has determined it to be in the public interest to resolve this matter as set forth below.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, with Dr. Pamfilis' consent, it is ORDERED that:

1. The Board shall issue Dr. Pamfilis a medical license on the following conditions:

- a. Dr. Pamfilis shall practice only in a setting and location that has first been approved in writing by the Board's Office of Medical Director ("OMD") by contacting the Board's Monitoring Coordinator at boardmonitoring@ncmedboard.org.
- b. Dr. Pamfilis shall ensure that his employer or a colleague, monitor or supervisor approved by the Board's OMD submits at least one letter to the Board's OMD regarding his competency with clinical care to the Board's Monitoring Coordinator. This letter should be provided to the Board's OMD after Dr. Pamfilis has been

engaged in his Reentry Plan for at least three (3) months.

- c. Dr. Pamfilis shall start this Reentry Plan within twelve (12) months of the date of this Reentry Agreement.
- d. Dr. Pamfilis' North Carolina medical license shall not be issued until he has a Reentry Plan approved by the Board's OMD and he is ready to begin such Reentry Plan.
- e. This Reentry Plan shall continue until the Board's OMD has approved it as completed. Once Dr. Pamfilis has been successfully practicing for six (6) continuous months pursuant to this Reentry Plan, he may petition the Board's OMD to end the Reentry Plan by contacting the Board's Monitoring Coordinator.
- f. The above conditions listed in paragraphs 1(a) - 1(e) shall constitute Dr. Pamfilis' Reentry Plan back into the practice of medicine and shall continue in effect until the Board's OMD determines that the Reentry Plan is complete.

2. Dr. Pamfilis shall obey all laws. Likewise, Dr. Pamfilis shall obey all rules and regulations involving the practice of medicine.

3. Dr. Pamfilis shall notify the Board in writing of any change in his residence and practice addresses within ten (10) days of the change.

4. Dr. Pamfilis shall meet with the Board or members of the Board for an investigative interview at such times as requested by the Board.

5. If Pamfilis fails to comply with any of the terms of this Reentry Agreement, that failure shall constitute unprofessional conduct within the meaning of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-14(a)(6) and shall be grounds, after any required notice and hearing, for the Board to annul, revoke, suspend or limit his license or to deny any application he might then have pending or might make in the future for a license.

6. This Reentry Agreement shall take effect immediately upon its execution by both Dr. Pamfilis and the Board, and it shall continue in effect until Dr. Pamfilis is notified by the Board that his Reentry Plan is complete.

7. Dr. Pamfilis hereby waives any requirement under any law or rule that this Reentry Agreement be served on him.

8. Upon execution by Dr. Pamfilis and the Board, this Reentry Agreement shall become a public record within the meaning of Chapter 132 of the North Carolina General Statutes and shall be

subject to public inspection and dissemination pursuant to the provisions thereof.
