This matter is before the North Carolina Medical Board ("Board") regarding information provided to the Board concerning Clifford Tau Wang, M.D. ("Dr. Wang"). Dr. Wang makes the following admissions, and the Board makes the following findings and conclusions:

STATUTORY AUTHORITY

The Board is a body duly organized under the laws of North Carolina and is the proper party to bring this proceeding under the authority granted to it in Article 1 of Chapter 90 of the North Carolina General Statutes and the rules and regulations promulgated thereto.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Dr. Wang was first issued a license to practice medicine by the Board on or about April 27, 2017, license number 2017-00912.

At all times relevant hereto, Dr. Wang practiced emergency medicine in Long Beach, California.

On January 28, 2023, Dr. Wang entered into a Consent Decree with the Wyoming Board of Medicine ("Wyoming Board") in which he

was reprimanded and ordered to pay a fine of \$500.00 for failing to respond Wyoming Board staff during a random Continuing Medical Education hours audit for the period of 2018 to 2021.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Dr. Wang's conduct, as described above, constitutes Dr. Wang's license to practice medicine being restricted or acted against by the licensing authority of any jurisdiction within the meaning of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-14(a)(13) which is grounds under that section of the North Carolina General Statutes for the Board to annul, suspend, revoke, condition, or limit Dr. Wang's license to practice medicine or to deny any application he may make in the future.

PROCEDURAL STIPULATIONS

Dr. Wang acknowledges and agrees that the Board has jurisdiction over him and over the subject matter of this case.

Dr. Wang knowingly waives his right to any hearing and to any judicial review or appeal in this case.

Dr. Wang acknowledges that he has read and understands this Consent Order and enters into it voluntarily.

Dr. Wang desires to resolve this matter without the need for more formal proceedings.

The Board has determined that it is in the public interest to resolve this case as set forth below.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, with Dr. Wang's consent, it is ORDERED that:

1. Dr. Wang is hereby REPRIMANDED.
2. This Consent Order shall take effect immediately upon its execution by both Dr. Wang and the Board, and it shall continue in effect until specifically ordered otherwise by the Board.
3. Dr. Wang hereby waives any requirement under any law or rule that this Consent Order be served on him.
4. Upon execution by Dr. Wang and the Board, this Consent Order shall become a public record within the meaning of Chapter 132 of the North Carolina General Statutes and shall be subject to public inspection and dissemination pursuant to the provisions thereof. Additionally, it will be reported to persons, entities, agencies, and clearinghouses as required and permitted by law including, but not limited to, the Federation of State Medical Boards and the National Practitioner Data Bank.



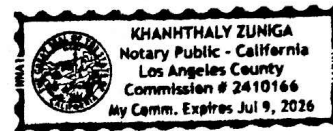
