Dear Mr. Andrews:

The North Carolina Medical Board (“Board”) has decided to issue you a physician assistant license. However, as a result of information reviewed while evaluating your license application, the Board has also decided to issue you this public letter of concern and impose a \$2,500.00 fine. The Board notes that you paid the fine on June 6, 2022. The Board does not consider a public letter of concern to be a disciplinary action or a limitation or restriction on your license. However, the Board does consider the fine to be disciplinary in nature.

The Board is concerned that you failed to disclose the following in your license application with respect to the Regulatory Action section and Question #1 which, in relevant part, asks about other regulatory entity investigations.

- 10/12/2016 The Indiana Physician Assistant Committee (“Indiana Committee”) denied your physician assistant application for renewal because you failed to tell the Indiana Committee about a April 20, 2016, Final Decision and Order that you entered into with the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (“Wisconsin Board”) that imposed a reprimand and required that you pay \$798.00 in costs for practicing outside the scope of your physician assistant license and failing to cooperate in a timely manner with the Wisconsin Board investigation.
- 6/26/2017 The Indiana Committee issued a Decision Following Personal Appearance that reinstated your Indiana physician assistant license subject to a minimum two-year probation.
- 11/8/2017 The Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs Bureau of Professional Licensing Task Force on Physician’s Assistants Disciplinary Subcommittee (“Michigan Subcommittee”) filed an Administrative Complaint against you alleging that you failed to timely report the April 20, 2016, Wisconsin Board Final Decision and Order to the Michigan Subcommittee.

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
- 10/23/2018 You entered into a Consent Order with the Michigan Subcommittee that resolved the November 8, 2017, Michigan Subcommittee Administrative Complaint and you were fined \$250.00.
- 4/11/2019 The Indiana Committee issued a Findings of Fact, Ultimate Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order that indefinitely suspended your Indiana physician assistant license for failing to comply with the June 26, 2017, Indiana Committee Decision Following Personal Appearance.
- 11/20/2019 The Wisconsin Board issued a Final Decision and Order that imposed a reprimand and required you to pay \$310.00 in costs because you failed to report the October 23, 2018, Michigan Subcommittee Consent Order to the Wisconsin Board.

The Board notes that you did not disclose the above investigations and regulatory actions because you believed that the Board would receive that information via the National Practitioner Data Bank. While you were correct in your belief, that does not eliminate your responsibility to answer the Board's application questions responsively, accurately, and truthfully.

The Board urges you to take steps to ensure that the conduct giving rise to the Board's concerns does not happen again. Otherwise, the Board may take additional action against your North Carolina license. If that happens, this letter may be reviewed in determining the appropriate action.

This letter is a public record within the meaning of Chapter 132 of the North Carolina General Statutes and is subject to public inspection and dissemination as required by that law. It will be reported to the Federation of State Medical Boards.




