This matter is before the North Carolina Medical Board ("Board") on the request of Kunal Kapoor, M.D. ("Dr. Kapoor") for a timeframe extension of his Special Purpose License in the state of North Carolina, originally issued through a Special Purpose License Agreement on December 1, 2022, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-12.2A. Dr. Kapoor agrees, and the Board finds and concludes, that:

Dr. Kapoor holds a full and unrestricted license to practice medicine in the country of India.

Dr. Kapoor does not have any current or pending disciplinary or other action against him by any medical licensing entity or body in any state or other jurisdiction.

Dr. Kapoor is a General Surgeon.

Dr. Kapoor was initially issued a Special Purpose License pursuant to a Special Purpose License Agreement dated December 1, 2022. Dr. Kapoor's Special Purpose License permitted him to be a clinical fellow at the University of North Carolina, Department of Surgery, Abdominal Transplant Division, beginning

November 21, 2022, and ending June 30, 2024.

Dr. Kapoor's Special Purpose License was renewed after June 30, 2024, without the execution of an Amended Special Purpose License Agreement.

Dr. Kapoor seeks an Amended Special Purpose License Agreement to facilitate a retroactive extension of his Special Purpose License, from June 30, 2024, to January 31, 2026, to practice as a clinical fellow at the University of North Carolina, Department of Surgery, Abdominal Transplant Division.

The Board has determined that Dr. Kapoor has satisfied all the requirements for extending the timeframe of his Special Purpose License pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-12.2A.

The Board has determined it to be in the public interest to extend the timeframe of Dr. Kapoor's Special Purpose License as set forth below.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, with Dr. Kapoor's consent and agreement, it is ORDERED that:

1. The Board shall extend the timeframe of Dr. Kapoor's Special Purpose License to practice medicine within the meaning of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-12.2A.

2. The extension and limitations of the Special Purpose License issued to Dr. Kapoor shall be as follows:

- a. The Special Purpose License shall retroactively come into effect at 12:01 a.m., June 30, 2024, and shall expire at midnight on January 31, 2026; and
- b. Dr. Kapoor shall not practice medicine with his North Carolina Special Purpose License outside the limitations set forth in this Amended Special Purpose License Agreement. Specifically, Dr. Kapoor's practice as a physician is limited to his participation as a clinical fellow at the University of North Carolina, Department of Surgery, Abdominal Transplant Division.

3. Dr. Kapoor shall obey all laws. Likewise, he shall obey all rules and regulations involving the practice of medicine.


4. If Dr. Kapoor fails to comply with any of the terms and conditions of this Amended Special Purpose License Agreement, that failure shall constitute unprofessional conduct within the meaning of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-14(a)(6) and shall be grounds, after any required notice and hearing, for the Board to annul, suspend, or revoke his Special Purpose License and to deny any application he might make in the future or then have pending for a license.

5. Dr. Kapoor hereby waives any requirement under any law or rule that this Amended Special Purpose License Agreement be served on him.

6. Upon execution by Dr. Kapoor and the Board, this Amended Special Purpose License Agreement shall become a public record within the meaning of Chapter 132 of the North Carolina General Statutes and shall be subject to public inspection and dissemination pursuant to the provisions thereof. Additionally, it will be reported to persons, entities, agencies, and clearinghouses as required and permitted by law.

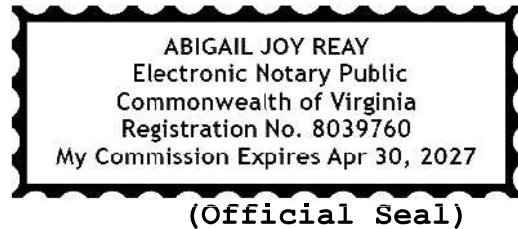
