This matter is before the North Carolina Medical Board (“Board”) on the application of Kunal Kapoor, M.D. (“Dr. Kapoor”) for a Special Purpose License pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-12.2A. Dr. Kapoor agrees, and the Board finds and concludes that:

Dr. Kapoor holds a full and unrestricted license to practice medicine and surgery in the country of India.

Dr. Kapoor does not have any current or pending disciplinary or other action against him by any medical licensing entity or body in any state or other jurisdiction.

Dr. Kapoor is a General Surgery physician.

Dr. Kapoor seeks to be a clinical fellow at the University of North Carolina, Department of Surgery, Abdominal Transplant Division, beginning November 21, 2022, and ending June 30, 2024.

The Board has determined that Dr. Kapoor has satisfied all the requirements for a Special Purpose License pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-12.2A.

The Board has determined it to be in the public interest to issue a Special Purpose License as set forth below.

Now, therefore, with Dr. Kapoor’s consent and agreement, it is ORDERED that:

1. The Board shall issue Dr. Kapoor a Special Purpose License to practice medicine and surgery within the meaning of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-12.2A.
2. The limitations of the Special Purpose License issued to Dr. Kapoor shall be as follows:

a. The Special Purpose License shall come into effect at 12:01 a.m., November 22, 2022, and shall expire at midnight on June 30, 2024;

b. Dr. Kapoor may only use his North Carolina Special Purpose License to practice medicine and surgery as a clinical fellow at the University of North Carolina, Department of Surgery, Abdominal Transplant Division. Dr. Kapoor shall not practice medicine or surgery with his Special Purpose License outside the limitations set forth in this Special Purpose License Agreement.

3. Dr. Kapoor shall obey all laws. Likewise, Dr. Kapoor shall obey all rules and regulations involving the practice of medicine.

4. If Dr. Kapoor fails to comply with any of the terms of this Special Purpose License Agreement, that failure shall constitute unprofessional conduct within the meaning of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-14(a)(6) and shall be grounds, after any required notice and hearing, for the Board to annul, suspend or revoke this Special Purpose License to practice medicine and surgery and to deny any application Dr. Kapoor might make in the future or then have pending for a license.

5. This Special Purpose License Agreement shall take effect immediately upon its execution by both Dr. Kapoor and the Board.

6. The Board has jurisdiction over Dr. Kapoor for all purposes set forth in or related to Article 1 of Chapter 90 of the North Carolina General Statutes, and such jurisdiction over Dr. Kapoor shall continue in effect even after the expiration of Dr. Kapoor's Special Purpose License.

7. Dr. Kapoor hereby waives any requirement under any law or rule that this Special Purpose License Agreement be served on his.

8. Upon execution by Dr. Kapoor and the Board, this Special Purpose License Agreement shall become a public record within the meaning of Chapter 132 of the North

Carolina General Statutes and shall be subject to public inspection and dissemination pursuant to the provisions thereof.
